

Club Championship Race Rules

**Effective 1st January 2012
until further notice**

Qualification for the Bedford Harriers Club Championships is based on the following;

Must be a fully paid up member of Bedford Harriers before the event begins. Fully paid up means the Club's Treasurer must have received payment by cash or cheque, or if by bank payment, funds must be in the Bedford Harriers account, before the event begins. If cheque is returned by the paying bank or stopped by the cheque issuer the member is considered as not fully paid up.

Members must wear club kit.

Members must enter as a Bedford Harrier and be shown on the race entry list and results list as a Bedford Harrier.

Club Championship races will be run using the first past the post system. This method will be used for all senior and vet categories including cross country.

Where chip timing is in use results will be as detailed in the ARC rule book for road races, Rule 30 paragraph 4 reproduced below.

'Where chip timing detection is used at both the start and finish, prizes will be awarded on a "gun" to "chip finish" basis unless the race promoter has published alternative arrangements.'
